**Lithgow City Council Local Environment Plan - Great Western Highway Corridor between
Mount Victoria and Lithgow**

Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) has set boundaries for the proposed upgrade of the Great Western Highway between Mount Victoria and Lithgow.

Mapping for the proposed boundaries (in .shp format) has been provided to Sherilyn Hanrahan of Lithgow City Council by Chris Hall of RMS.

RMS seeks Council's cooperation in including the proposed new road boundaries for this section of the Great Western Highway in its Local Environment Plan (LEP) as SP2 Infrastructure Zone (Classified Road).

I can advise that the RMS agrees to being nominated as the Relevant Acquisition Authority on the understanding that this nomination only applies to the current and future routes of the Great Western Highway. Separate agreement is required should other SP2 Infrastructure Zones for classified roads be mapped in the future.

RMS policy requires that roads be 'permissible with consent' in SP2 zones. This is to ensure that attention is drawn to any major development that could otherwise occur without RMS or Council's knowledge.
